#### Rules

- A. Selection will be made on the basis of neatness of appearance, simplicity of pattern and usefulness of decoration.
- B. No sugar starch will be permitted.
- C. More than one piece in a set, fasten together and mount for display.
- D. Specify kit or original.
- E. Limit 5 entries per class.
- F. Either an Excellent, Very Good or Participation ribbon will be awarded to each entry. First, second, and third place ribbons will be awarded in each class. There is one Best of Show for each subdivision.

### Subdivision A

- 1. Clothing
- Fabric Work (such as braided rug, stuffed toy, pillow)
- 3. Woven Item

### Subdivision B

- Quilts Combination Hand & Machine Stitched by entrant
- 5. Quilts Hand pieced & Hand Quilted
- 6. Quilts Hand or Machine pieced by entrant, commercially quilted

### Subdivision C

- 7. Knitted Work- large
- 8. Knitted Work small

- 9. Crocheted Work large
- 10. Crocheted Work small
- 11. Tatting

## Subdivision D

- 12. Counted Cross Stitch
- Embroidery Miscellaneous (such as Bargello, Candlewicking, Crewel, Reticello, Smocking, Swedish Embroidery, Trapunto)
- 14. Embroidery Standard
- 15. Needlepoint
- Miscellaneous Handiwork including latch hook, yarn punch, hand felted item, etc.
